Rabbi Jay Miller Speaks for Peninsula Clergy Network

Rabbi Jay Miller was selected by the Peninsula Community Foundation in 2002, to serve as the founding Executive Director of the Peninsula Clergy Network, a multi-faith professional association of the clergy on the Peninsula.

From 1995 – 2002, he served as the interim Executive Director of six community non-profit agencies. He helped to restructure agencies dedicated to serving the homeless preschool children, community arts, human rights, and education.

From 1977-1995, he served as the rabbi for San Diego's college and university communities. He has served as a synagogue rabbi in congregations in southern

California and the Bay Area.

He earned his Masters Degree in Judaic Studies and was ordained at the Hebrew Union College. Rabbi Miller received his B.A. in political science from UC Berkeley.

Rabbi Miller has served as a consultant for the State of California as a specialist on multi-
